The feast of reason and the flow of soul brought us to the Yakima Valley to source Cabernet Sauvignon from the high southern slopes of Elephant Mountain Vineyards. The microclimate of the Rattlesnake Hills Appellation produces fruit that has great structure, with higher tannin levels that balance perfectly with complex fruit flavors that is unique to this growing region.
